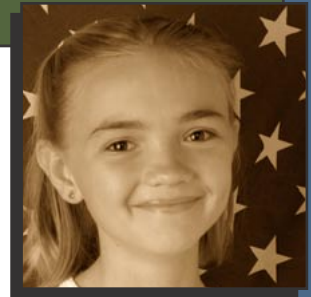
A View from the Summit...

Beer fan takes bottles to the grave

A 72-year-old who claims to have drunk nothing but beer for 30 years has made sure there are bottles at his final resting place.

Slobodan Ristivojevic from Yugoslavia says he gave up drinking anything but beer in 1972 and has since guzzled 100,000 bottles.

He has now had his grave specially designed with two bottles of beer cemented into the headstone. Slobodan claims he isn't an alcoholic and now only drinks six bottles a day - down from 20 a day a few years ago.

The man from Arandjelovac says he couldn't imagine drinking water again, fearing it could even make him collapse.

He told Serbian daily Glas Javnosti about his headstone: "One beer is for me and another one for my loving wife Slavka. She drinks water too but likes beer and when we die I want to be sure we'll have beer there at the cemetery as well.

"There is no drink that refreshes like beer. I used to drink up to 20 bottles a day but nowadays it's only about six a day. I'm not an alcoholic, but I simply can't drink anything else but beer. If I were to drink a glass of water right now I think I'd just collapse on the floor."

Cooking With Beer

Texas Beer Battered Fried Shrimp

Peanut oil (enough to fry within skillet)
1 cup flour
2 tsp paprika
1/4 tsp cayenne pepper
1 tsp salt
1 1/2 cups beer of your choice
extra flour (enough to coat shrimp; approx. 1 cup)
1 1/2 lbs raw shrimp, peeled and deveined



Preheat peanut oil in a large, deep pot or deep-fryer to 400 deg F. Combine flour, paprika, cayenne pepper, and salt. Gradually beat in beer until batter is quite thin. Place extra flour in a bowl. Dip each shrimp into extra flour first, and then into the batter. Deep fry in peanut oil for 2 minutes. Place shrimp on paper towels to drain. Serve hot. Serves 4-6.

For the beer enthusiast who wants to be a beer entrepreneur, contract brewing is very attractive. Contract brewing is when the beer is brewed at a regional brewery or another microbrewer, but is owned by the person or company that owns the beer.

One of the best known contract brewers in America is Pete Slosberg, president of Pete's Wicked Brewing Company. Pete's Wicked is based out of Palo Alto, California. Pete owns no breweries and brews no beers, yet their sales are extraordinary. How? Pete's Wicked contract brews their beers with regional breweries that can produce the quantity and quality necessary.

Pete didn't have enough money to start a brewery, but he was a wild beer enthusiast who decided he could promote beer better than he could brew. The recipes are owned by Pete's Wicked Brewing Company and were originally brewed out of Schell Brewing in New Ulm, Minnesota. But when things got a little bigger, Pete's got a new contract and moved his operations to the bigger Minnesota Brewing Company in St. Paul, Minnesota. But, in 1995 Pete's Wicked grew even more popular and they moved their base of brewing to Stroh's Brewery, also in St. Paul.
