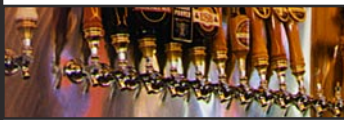

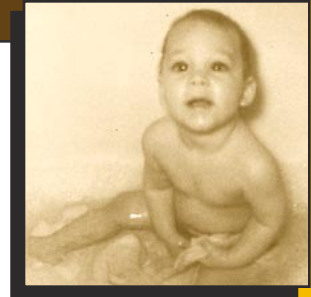
The staff of the Cumming location would like to congratulate The Giacomarro Family! Their son, Charlie has just committed to play football at Lehigh University.

Industry News!

Nice Cans!

Due to pressure from the European Union (EU) to comply with common packaging rules, Denmark is lifting a 20-year ban on selling beers and soft drinks in metal cans.

The EU Commission had threatened legal action against Denmark over the ban, citing a requirement that individual members cannot block the marketing of packaging that has been approved by the 15-nation bloc.

Previously, Danish governments insisted on using refillable and reusable bottles for environmental reasons, but are complying with the EU's position, and are using a deposit system with the cans to ensure they are being recycled and reused.

Consumers will pay a refundable 1.5 kroner (about 18 cents US) deposit for cans produced in Denmark.



Beer Spotlight

Guinness Stout

Brewed in Dublin, Ireland

This venerable, rich, dark-brown confection is a must for anyone's drinking pleasure, whether on draft or in a bottle. Mildly roasted, shaded with a wee bit o' chocolate malt and sublimely creamy-smooth, it is universally appreciated for its delightful moderate bitterness and sweetish, roasted malt aroma. Always be sure to tell the bartender to pour the creamy-white head so that it rises "just proud of the rim."

Guinness says otherwise, but many devotees believe its stout varies in strength and character from country to country. Ostensibly, sweeter and stronger versions are enjoyed in the Caribbean and Africa; American taps are said to deliver softer, less biting pints. Decide for yourself.

Cooking With Beer...

Grilled Teriyaki Fish

- 1 1/4 cup honey, warmed
- 1/3 cup light soy sauce, or 3 Tbsp tamari sauce
- 1/3-cup porter, stout, or smoked beer
- 2 Tbsp olive oil or other vegetable oil
- 1 Tbsp sugar
- 1 Tbsp dark sesame oil
- 2 cloves garlic, finely minced and crushed
- 1/8 tsp hot red chili flakes, ground (optional)
- 1 tsp ground ginger or 1/2 tsp fresh ginger, chopped
- 1/2 tsp liquid smoke (optional)
- Freshly ground black pepper to taste
- 2/3-cup flour
- 4 lbs mahi-mahi or other firm fish, or large shelled shrimp, or sea scallops

*Whisk together the first 11 ingredients and let stand at room temperature for 1 hour.

*Brush marinade over fish and refrigerate for 2 hours before grilling.

*Sprinkle the fish with flour and grill, basting often with marinade.

Eggplant Casserole

- 1 medium eggplant, peeled and cubed
- 2 tablespoons margarine
- 1/2-cup bread or cracker crumbs
- 1-teaspoon salt
- 1/4-teaspoon pepper
- 1/4-cup milk
- 1 egg beaten
- 1/2 cup American cheese, grated

Cook eggplant in small amount of boiling, salted water until tender. Drain and mash. Add margarine, breadcrumbs, salt, pepper, milk, beaten egg and 1/4 cup grated cheese; mix well. Pour into buttered casserole. Top with remaining cheese. Bake at 350 degrees for about 20 minutes. Enjoy!!!

Moosehead Madness

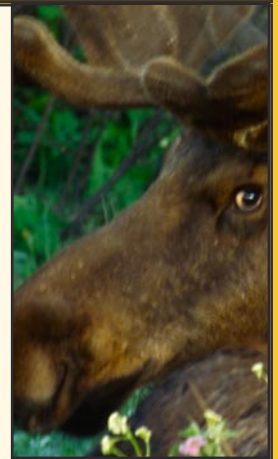

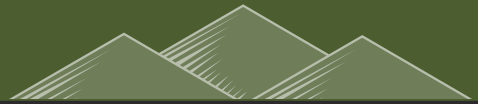

Did You Know?

The history of Irish brewing is inextricably linked to Arthur Guinness. He used 100 pounds left to him by a benefactor to open a small brewery in County Kildare in 1756. Three years later he moved to Dublin and took a lease on a disused brewery in St. James's Gate at an annual rent of 45 pounds. He brewed ale but in 1799 he decided to challenge the English brewers' domination of the Irish market by switching production to porter with the aid of a brewer hired from London. His business expanded rapidly and he used canals and the new railway system to sell the porter nationally. Guinness produced two beers, X and XX. The XX was later renamed Extra Porter Stout while a third beer, Foreign Extra Porter Stout, was developed for export to the British colonies. Eventually the term "porter" was dropped and the beers became known simply as stout.
