

Cooking With Beer...

Chocolate Malt Waffles

- 2 eggs
- 1 cup malty lager
- 1/4 cup unsweetened cocoa powder
- 1/4 cup malted milk powder (you may substitute Ovaltine)
- 1 1/2 cups flour
- 2 tsp baking powder
- 1/2 tsp salt
- 4 Tbsp butter
- 2 oz bittersweet chocolate, chopped
- Cooking oil spray

- *Preheat a waffle iron. Blend the eggs and lager.
- *Sift together the sugar, cocoa, malted milk powder, flour, baking powder, and salt.
- *Blend the wet and dry ingredients in a large mixing bowl until just combined; the batter will be lumpy.
- *Melt together the butter and chocolate in a glass measuring cup set in the microwave and covered loosely with plastic wrap

(butter sometimes erupts in the microwave). Heat on high for 1 minute, stir, then return to heat for another 30-40 seconds.

*Use a fork to stir the melted butter and chocolate until warm, not hot. Blend the butter-chocolate mixture into the batter.

*Spritz the waffle iron griddle with cooking oil spray and place 1/3 - 1/2 cup batter in the center. Use a spatula to spread it slightly, then cook accordingly to the waffle iron manufacturer's instructions. About 2-3 minutes is the usual cooking time for a 6-inch Belgium style waffle (or until steam is no longer visible from the sides of the closed waffle iron).



Did You Know?

The state of Washington licenses about 120 companies to sell beer. About two-thirds of these are small, local breweries, which compete for the 10% of the market not already spoken for by imports and large domestic beer makers.

Beer labels often reflect the era in which they were used. During WWII, labels encouraged the use of war bonds, and in the 1950s and early 1960s many labels were designed in the shape of a television screen.

Non-alcoholic brews are comparatively low in calories, with a 12-oz bottle having anywhere from 55 to 90 calories. Most so-called light beers, on the other hand, have between 95 and 135 calories.

4 oz brandy

About 3/4 pint soda water, chilled

Slices of seasonal fruit, such as apples, pears, oranges, lemons, peaches, and strawberries

Put ice, brandy, and red wine in a large bowl. Stir. Add soda water to taste and float the fruit on top.
