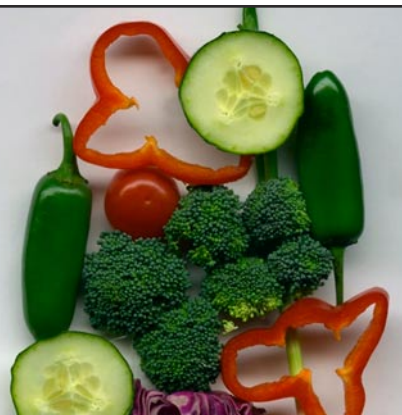

Lord, grant me energy enough to be bread-baker and breadwinner, knee patcher and peacemaker, ball player and bill juggler.

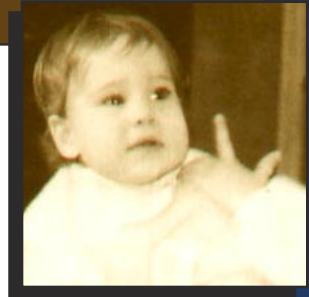


Lord, grant me hands enough to wipe away the tears, to reach out when I'm needed, to hug and to hold, to tickle and to touch.

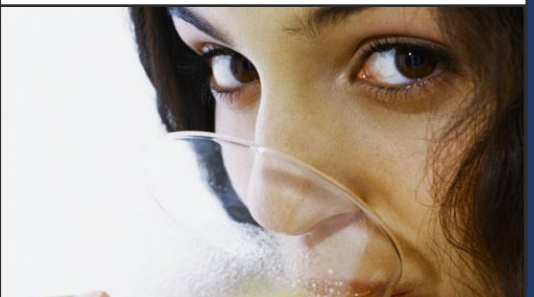

Cooking With Beer...

Shrimp Poached in Beer

- 2 quarts water
- 7 cloves garlic
- 3 bay leaves
- 2 Tbsp shrimp boil seasoning (such as Old Bay)
- 3 lemon slices
- 2 Tbsp salt
- 24 oz chili beer, very cold
- 12 ice cubes
- 12 oz dark lager
- 2 lb shrimp, 16-20-count medium, with shells and tails attached

• Place the first 6 items into a 1-gallon stockpot and bring to a boil. Place the chili beer and ice cubes together in a large metal bowl.

• When the water is boiling vigorously, add the dark lager and the shrimp. Stir well, and let cook for just a few minutes until the shells turn pink.

• As soon as the shrimp are cooked, remove with a slotted spoon and place in the icy chili beer.

• When the shrimp are cool enough to touch, remove from the icy beer and place on a platter. Serve with a honey-mustard dipping sauce or horseradish sauce on the side.

Sweet Tea Mandated?

ATLANTA -- For some Georgia lawmakers, a meal wouldn't be complete without sweet tea. Now they could put that into law.

Rep. John Noel, D-Atlanta, and four co-sponsors filed a bill Tuesday that would make it a misdemeanor "of a high and aggravated nature" not to offer sweet tea in any Georgia restaurant that serves iced tea.

Noel acknowledged the bill was an attempt to bring a little humor to the Legislature. But he said he wouldn't mind if it became law.

Under the bill, restaurants could still serve unsweetened tea, but must serve sweet tea as well. The proposed bill specifies the tea must be sweetened when it is brewed.

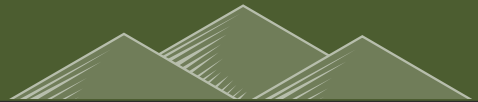
Misdemeanors can carry a sentence of up to 12 months in jail.
