### Tuppers' Hop Pocket Ale

**Region of Origin:** Mid-Atlantic US  
**Style:** American Ale

Bob Tupper is a history teacher who gives lectures on beer at a famous bar, The Brickseller, in Washington, D.C.. He and his wife Ellie, an editor, designed this beer, which is produced by the local Old Dominion brewery. It has a flowery aroma; a crisp, cedary, malt background; and a wood-bark bitterness in its big, lingering finish. A hop "pocket" is the long sack in which pressed hops are packed. It looks like a boxer's punchbag; this beer hops and hits with the best. The more recent Hop Pocket Pils has a dizzyingly heady character.

## Beer Recipes...

### Lamb Patties Seared in Rosemary Stout

- 4 ground lamb patties, about 4-5 oz each
- 12 oz sweet stout
- 2 Tbsp fresh rosemary leaves
- Cracked black pepper to taste
- 2 cups fresh bread crumbs

- \*Place lamb patties in a glass 9x9-inch baking dish. Combine the stout and rosemary leaves and pour over the patties. Cover tightly with plastic wrap and let marinate in the refrigerator overnight.
- \*Remove the lamb patties from the marinade and strain the reserved liquid through a mesh sieve.
- \*Blend the rosemary leaves and pepper with the bread crumbs using a food processor fitted with a metal blade.
- \*Preheat the oven to 350 deg F.
- \*Press a layer of the seasoned bread crumbs into both sides of each lamb patty.
- \*Place a heavy nonstick skillet over high heat, and sear the lamb patties on both sides, turning after just 3-4 mins to prevent burning.
- \*Place the seared lamb patties on a baking sheet lined with foil. Bake for 20 mins for lamb patties that are still pink and juicy inside, 30 mins for well-done lamb patties.

## Industry News...

### Posters speak their drinking warning

Posters which play corny chat-up lines are being posted in pub toilets as a warning against drinking too much. The group behind the advert said they wanted to show what happens when someone may appear more attractive than they are after a few drinks. Each poster has a built-in speaker which plays a pre-recorded one-liner when a person walking past triggers a sensor. Jean Coussins, chief executive of the Portman Group, a body which promotes sensible drinking, said: "We want them to surprise and engage people and to make them think about their drinking." Researchers at the Portman Group, which is funded by the alcohol drinks industry, searched the internet to find the worst chat-up lines. The posters are the latest stage in its anti-drunkenness campaign called "If you do do drink, don't do drunk." One of the adverts which will appear in the ladies, says: "When they made the alphabet they should have put U and I together." It features the close-up of a man wearing a studded dog collar above the words: "If you do do drink, don't do him." Another which will go up in the gents shows a grey-haired woman with protruding teeth and says "Excuse me. Do you mind if I stare at your face a minute, I want to remember it for my dreams." The talking posters will appear in 25 venues throughout Britain, including the Slug and Lettuce chain. Non-speaking versions will also appear in 200 pubs and clubs. ## Did You Know?

### Selected Glossary Items

**Adulteration:** the debasement of a drink by adding a weaker liquid, usually water. The word 'adultery' derives from the same source. Cyril Pearl, in his *Beer, Glorious Beer!*, reveals that the addition of water to beer by publicans has long been an Australian problem. Australians drink beer at such low temperatures that changes in taste are not noticed.

**Balderdash:** this word at first referred to frothy liquid, such as soapy water. By the 17th century it was used of any mixture of drinks that did not naturally blend, such as beer and wine, milk and beer. It was then used metaphorically of speech that did not make sense - non-sense. The ultimate origin of the word is unknown.
