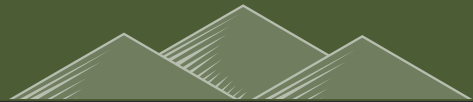
Beer Spotlight

Dinkelacker Dark Lager

Origin: Stuttgart, Germany

Moderate, chewy sweetness that almost immediately turns a bit sharp and yummy; slight burnt-carmel taste lingers and remains tantalizingly around the roof of the mouth; maltier, rather than hoppier with attendant, almost bland smoothness; not really dark in color, but medium-brown with orange-red overtones and some murkiness.

Beer Recipes...

Stout Cheesecake

Crust

- 1 1/2 cups Oreo cookie crumbs
- 2 Tbsp melted butter

Filling

- 3 lbs cream cheese
- 1 7/8 cup sugar
- Pinch salt
- 1 1/2 tsp cornstarch
- Juice of 2 lemons
- 4 eggs
- 1/2 cup heavy cream
- 1 cup stout

Garnish:

fruit

- *Combine crust ingredients, and press firmly into the bottom of a 9-inch springform pan, making sure to seal edges with crumbs.
- *Soften cream cheese in mixer until smooth with no lumps. Add sugar, and mix until smooth. Add salt, cornstarch, and lemon juice, and mix at medium-low speed.
- *Add eggs, one at a time, scraping sides of mixing bowl occasionally and fully incorporating each egg before adding the next.
- *Add heavy cream, and mix thoroughly. Add stout, and mix thoroughly. Pour into crust.
- *Bake at 425 deg F in a conventional oven, or 400 deg F in a convection oven for 8 mins., or until golden brown on top. Lower temp to 225 deg F (200 deg F convection), and bake for 1 hour and 15 mins. Let cool for 3 hours before serving. Garnish with fruit of choice.

DUI on a lawnmower?

A Wisconsin man has been charged with drink-driving on his lawnmower. Barry Davis, from West Bend, appeared in court on a charge of operating a motor vehicle while intoxicated. Davis admitted to drinking a six-pack of beer but said he didn't know driving a lawnmower while intoxicated was illegal.

A criminal complaint said a police officer pulled Davis over after seeing the mower swerving and watching it nearly go into a ditch to avoid traffic. Washington County Assistant District Attorney Peter Cannon said state statute defines a motor vehicle as any vehicle that is self-propelled.

Davis spent a night in Washington County Jail and was then released on bail. He's scheduled to return to court on September 3 for further proceedings.
