Chicks Fantasy Football

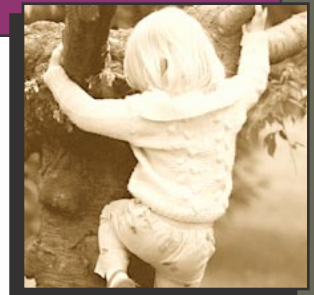

Beer Recipes...

Pumpkin-Spiced Salmon

- 2 quarts pumpkin ale
- 1 cup honey
- 1/2 cup brown sugar
- 1 Tbsp cumin
- 1/4 cup pumpkin pie spice
- 1 1/2 tsp cinnamon
- 1/2 cup crushed pumpkin seeds
- 1 cup orange juice
- 1/4 cup arrowroot (can substitute 5/8 cup flour or 5 Tbsp cornstarch)
- 1 10-oz Atlantic salmon filet
- Vegetable oil
- Salt and pepper
- Garnish: toasted pumpkin seeds

*Prepare Pumpkin Glaze: In large pot over medium heat, combine ale, honey, brown sugar, cumin, pumpkin pie spice, cinnamon, and crushed pumpkin seeds. Reduce by half.

*Combine orange juice and arrowroot until smooth. Stir into Pumpkin Glaze mixture, and continue cooking until thickened.



Brush salmon filet with oil, and sprinkle with salt and pepper. Grill 3 minutes on each side for medium rare. Baste with pumpkin glaze while cooking.

Serve with additional Pumpkin Glaze and toasted pumpkin seeds.

It is reported the women claim the "broom formula" has dissuaded men from frequenting liquor dens in the area.

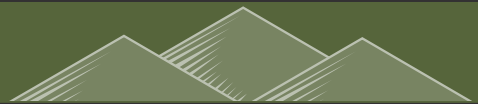

Did you know....

In Anglo Saxon times, drinking goblets were marked with pegs to show how much a person had drunk. This gave rise to the expression "To take someone down a peg or two". In England, inns in towns had to pay a tax known as a "Scot". Drinkers who went out of town to rural inns were described as drinking "Scot-free".



During the Middle Ages, governments and town councils in the British Isles and mainland Europe employed officials known as "Ale Conners" to test the quality of the ale brewed commercially. They would test it by pouring it onto a wooden bench, then sitting in the puddle. If their leather breeches stuck to the seat, the ale was considered to be of good quality.
