





Beer Spotlight

Sam Adams Winter

This year's Winter Lager is spiced with Curacao orange peel and fresh ginger. Winter Lager is a dark wheat bock with an herbal bitterness, intense flavor and a beautiful ruby hue. As a bock, it is brewed with extra malt, for a heartier, more full-bodied taste. A substantial portion of wheat malt is used in addition to two-row Harrington and caramel malts. The wheat malt gives this robust beer a lovely sharpness and a clean, crisp finish. Also detectable is a slight earthiness from the Goldings hops, which are added to the brew along with Saaz and Tettnang Tettnanger hops.

Beer Recipe: Braised Halibut with Vegetables and Herbs

3 Tbsp peeled and diced celery
 3 Tbsp peeled and diced carrots
 3 Tbsp diced red onion
 1/4 tsp minced garlic
 2 bay leaves
 1 tsp fresh thyme
 1/4 tsp black pepper
 3 Tbsp unsalted butter
 1 cup Thomas Kemper Hefeweizen, or other wheat beer
 1 cup fish or chicken stock
 1/4 tsp curry powder
 Pinch white sugar

2 Tbsp chopped Italian parsley
 4 halibut filets or steaks, 6-7 oz each
 Garnish: chopped parsley
 *Put all the ingredients except halibut into a large shallow pan, and bring to a boil. Boil for 1 min.
 *Add the halibut fillets, cover, and turn down the heat to low. Simmer for about 8 mins., or until halibut is cooked through. (Fish will feel firm to the touch when pressed.)
 *Remove fish to a serving platter or plates, and pour remaining broth over halibut portions. Garnish with chopped parsley.

Industry News

Three prisoners have been disciplined after visiting a pub and then sneaking back into their jail with alcohol. They are being held at Hollesley Bay open prison in Woodbridge, Suffolk.

The three inmates were spotted in a pub on October 27 by a local resident and police were informed. The Prison Service spokesman said the men had returned to the prison on their own and were disciplined when they arrived back.

A spokesman said the Prison Service was not aware of any other incidents at Hollesley Bay, but urged locals to contact police if they suspected "this sort of activity going on". Lord Archer was released from Hollesley Bay earlier this year after serving a sentence for perverting the course of justice.

Did you know....

The term 'toddlers' originated in England. There were impurities in the drinking water that disallowed the water to be used for drinking. A common alternative drink was beer (it was cheap, plentiful and the water used to make it was treated during the initial boiling during brewing). Toddlers, just weaning off of mothers milk were unaccustomed to the effects of beer. This coupled with the fact that they were just learning how to walk really made them toddle.....

Beer's origin actually comes from ancient Egypt. It was made with grains native to their region and intended for the Pharaoh but tasted a lot different from modern American beer. The straw was probably invented by Egyptian brewers to taste in-process beer without removing the fermenting ingredients which floated on the top of the container.
