Frankenheim Private Brewery was founded in Düsseldorf in 1873, when Heinrich Frankenheim laid the foundation stone for one of the most popular top-fermented dark beer specialties in the Rhineland, Altbier.

The company is now in the hands of Frankenheim's great-grandchildren, but the corporate philosophy handed down until today has remained: "Nothing is so good that it couldn't be improved".

## Beer Recipe

### Grilled Teriyaki Fish

#### Ingredients:

- 1/4 cup honey, warmed
- 1/3 cup light soy sauce or 3 tablespoons tamari sauce
- 1/3 cup Samuel Adams Honey Porter or Cream Stout
- 2 tablespoons olive or other vegetable oil
- 1 tablespoon sugar
- 1 tablespoon dark sesame oil
- 2 cloves garlic, finely minced and crushed
- 1/8 teaspoon ground ginger or 1/2 teaspoon fresh ginger, chopped
- 1/2 teaspoon liquid smoke (optional)
- freshly ground black pepper to taste
- 2/3 cup flour
- 4 pounds mahi-mahi or other firm fish, or large shelled shrimp, or sea scallops

#### Instructions:

Whisk together the first 11 ingredients and let stand at room temperature 1 hour. Brush marinade over fish and refrigerate for 2 hours before grilling. Sprinkle the fish with flour and grill, basting often with marinade.

## Industry News

### 'World record' drinking man fails to make Guinness book

A Latvian man who has amazed medics by surviving what police have described as a "world record drinking binge" has been told he won't get his name in the Guinness Book of Records.

Latvian police say the middle-aged man consumed around twice the blood-alcohol level considered deadly.

They say they found the unidentified drinker in an unconscious state, but medics found he was stable and recorded 7.22 parts per million of alcohol in a blood test, police spokeswoman Ieva Zvidre said.

An average person would vomit at around 1.2, lose consciousness at 3.0 and stop breathing at a level of about 4.0 parts per million, Ms Zvidre said, adding: "This is one for the Guinness Book of Records."

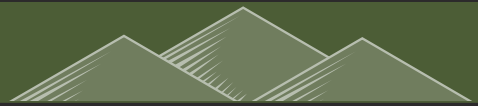
It is not known what alcoholic beverage the man drank.

Emergency ward head Martins Sics said there is no record of anybody having survived such a dose, even in neighbouring Russia which takes pride in its vodka-guzzling traditions. "He won't remember a thing when he comes to," Dr Sics said, reports gateway2russia.com.

A Guinness world records spokesman said: "We don't condone drinking large amounts of alcohol as it would just encourage people to drink more and more. We do not keep records on how much a single person has drunk."

However, the records book says Latvia is not one of the highest countries for total alcohol consumption per capita. Luxembourg is rated number one in the world for alcohol consumption, with each of its residents downing an average 12.4 litres of pure alcohol in a year. It is followed by the Czech Republic, whose citizens drank 10.9 litres, and Ireland which increased its intake to 10.8 litres.
