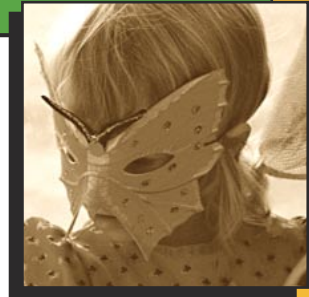

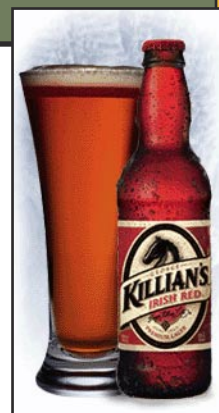


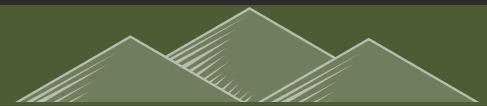
Beer Spotlight

Killians

Traditional lager with an authentic Irish heritage, based on the Killian family's recipe created for the Killian's brewery in Enniscorthy, Ireland, founded in 1864. Rich amber color and a thick, creamy head. Introduced into the U.S. in 1981. Gold medalist (amber lager) at 1998 World Beer Cup. Available nationally and packaged in bottles, cans and kegs. 163 calories per 12-ounce serving and 4.9 percent alcohol by volume.

Beer Recipe

Cherry Beer Cake Recipe

Ingredients

- 4 eggs
- 2 cups sugar
- 2 teaspoons vanilla
- 2 cups flour, sifted
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 2 tablespoons butter, melted
- 1 cup beer, plus 4 Tbsp (divided use)
- 1 cup maraschino cherries

Instructions

Preheat oven to 375 degrees F.

Beat eggs until thick and lemon colored. Gradually beat in sugar. Add vanilla. Fold sifted flour, baking powder and salt into egg mixture.

Heat beer. Add beer and melted butter at once to batter. Pour into greased cherry-lined tube or molded pan.

Bake at 375 degrees F. for 30 minutes. Turn out on cake rack to cool. Prick top of cake and drizzle with 4 tbsp of warm beer.

Yield: 10 servings

Sangre de Cristo Mountains

The Great Sand Dunes

Nestled in southern Colorado, North America's tallest dunes rise over 750 feet high against the rugged Sangre de Cristo Mountains. The wind shaped dunes glow beneath the rugged backdrop of the mountains. This geologic wonderland, containing 30 square miles of dunes, became a national monument in 1932. With the passage of the Great Sand Dunes National Park and Preserve Act of 2000, resources now also include alpine lakes and tundra, six peaks over 13,000' in elevation, ancient spruce and pine forests, large stands of aspen and cottonwood, grasslands, and wetlands--all habitat for diverse wildlife and plant species.

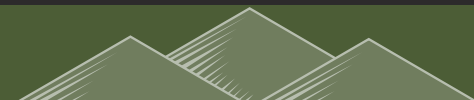
Hundreds of people are already said to have registered their details since Mr Payne launched the £5-a-month service last month. He said one bonus for men is that
