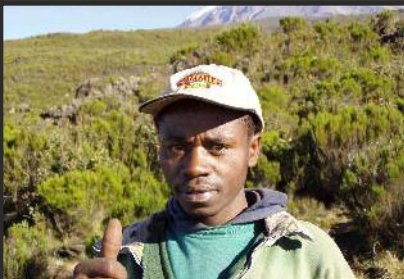

A couple of years ago I wrote about some of my favorite games. Since then I've gotten a lot more. One of the games that I've really enjoyed playing is 'WIT'S END'.

There are four different categories of questions. Depending on where you roll is the question you must answer. The categories are: Teaser, Odd1Out, Sequence, and Wild Card.

Teaser 1: is figuring out the comparison between two different sets of words. For example: fruit is to scrumping, as ideas are to: a)imagination, b)plagiarism, c)thought, or d)exchanges

Teaser 2: ultramarine is to sea, as ultramundane is to: a)boredom, b)exhaustion, c)solar system, or d)mountains

Odd1Out 1: is just like it sounds. You try to figure out which one doesn't belong. For example: Which one of these famous plays was not written in the 20th century: a)The Alchemist, b)Mother Courage, c)The Cherry Orchard, d)The Iceman Cometh

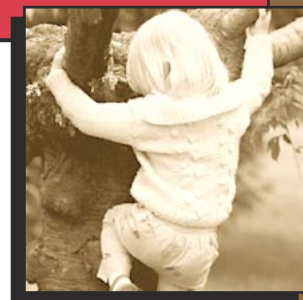
Odd1Out 2: Which one of these movie classics did not feature Elizabeth Taylor: a)Butterfield 8, b)Who's Afraid of Virginia Wolf?, c)I'll Cry Tomorrow, d)Suddenly Last Summer

Sequence 1: is, obviously, putting the events or things in the order the question is asking. For example: Arrange these planets in sequence according to diameter size (largest to smallest) Earth, Venus, Uranus

Sequence 2: List these football teams by the total number of Super Bowl victories between 1967-99 (most to least) Oakland/L.A. Raiders, Pittsburgh Steelers, Dallas Cowboys

Wild Card can be a number of different types of questions. I'll give you a few examples of these to give you an idea.

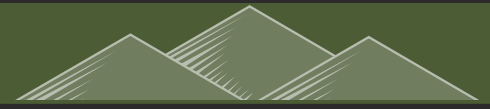
Beer Spotlight

Beer Recipe

Guinness Corned Beef

I discovered this tasty St. Patrick's day treat when I attended an Irish Rovers concert. My family and friends insist that it is a staple at get togethers any time of the year. Roast this corned beef slowly at a low setting for a melt in your mouth delight. The aroma is fantastic!

Ingredients:

- * 4 pounds of corned beef brisket.
- * 1 cup of brown sugar
- * 12 oz of Guinness Irish stout or your favorite stout beer

Preheat oven to 300° F (150° C). Rinse the beef completely and pat dry.

Place the brisket on rack in a roasting pan or Dutch oven. Rub the brown sugar on the corned beef to coat entire beef, including the bottom. Pour the bottle of stout beer around, and gently over the beef to wet the sugar.

Cover, and place in preheated oven. Bake for 2 1/2 hours. During the last hour, you may put vegetables in the roasting pan as well. Try a wedge of cabbage, new potatoes, onion, carrots, etc. You may need to add a little more beer with your vegetables.

Allow to rest 5 minutes before slicing.

Shrimp Chili Rellenos \$ 8.99

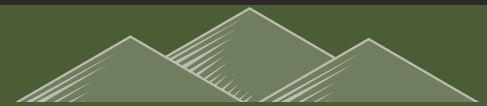
