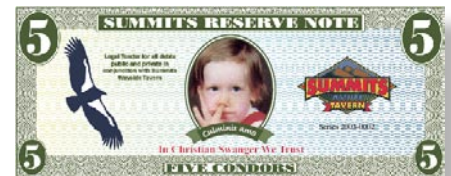

Rogue Chocolate Stout

The recipe for Rogue Chocolate Stout was created several years ago for export to Japan. The exported twelve ounce Chocolate Bear Beer bottle label is in Kanji and features a teddy bear with a pink heart on his belly. Chocolate Stout was released for Valentine's Day in 2001 in a twenty-two ounce bottle for the US market. The label features a Roguester (Sebbie Buhler) on the label.

Hedonistic! Ebony in color with a rich creamy head. The mellow flavor of oats, chocolate malts, and real chocolate are balanced perfectly with the right amount of hops for a bittersweet finish. Chocolate Stout is brewed with 10 ingredients: Northwest Harrington and Klages, Crystal 135-165 and Beeston Chocolate Malts, Cascade Hops, Rolled Oats and Roasted Barley, Natural Chocolate Flavor, Free Range Coastal Waters and PacMan Yeast. Chocolate Stout is available only in the classic 22-ounce bottle during a limited period and on draft at select accounts.

Cooking With Beer!

Pan-Fried Monkfish Medallions on Date, Apricot and Ale Compote with Plum Tomato Concasse

Ingredients

- 1kg/2lb monkfish tail, filleted, skinned & sliced thinly
- 6 plum tomatoes
- olive oil for frying
- compote
- 450g/1lb dates
- 450g/1lb apricots
- 175g/6oz caster sugar
- 2 cloves
- 1 stick cinnamon
- 175g/6oz unsalted butter
- 290ml/1/2 pint fruity bitter

Method

1. Soak dates and apricots in beer for at least 6 hours. Place all compote ingredients in a pan and simmer gently for 20 minutes, then remove from heat.
2. Soak plum tomatoes in boiling water for 2 minutes then remove, skin, de-seed and finely dice the flesh to make a concasse. Pan-fry monkfish slices in olive oil for

2 minutes on each side, then divide compote between 6 dinner plates, place monkfish pieces on top, and decorate with the plum tomato concasse.

Fuel Cells Clean Up Beer Brewing Process

May 10, 2004 [SolarAccess.com] FuelCell Energy, and Alliance Power entered into an arrangement by which Sierra Nevada Brewing Co. is expected to purchase four 250-kilowatt Direct FuelCell (DFC) power plants in late 2005 or early 2006. A joint venture of FuelCell Energy and Alliance Power will supply electric power and heat to the brewery's production processes until the fuel cells are delivered. FuelCell Energy and its U.S. distribution partner, PPL Energy Plus, have also completed the installation of a DFC power plant for Ocean County Community College (OCC) in New Jersey. The fuel cell will provide about 90 percent of the daily power requirements for OCC's Instructional Building, Lecture Hall and Nursing Arts Building and 20 percent of heating needs will be provided to those three buildings plus the Administration Building, Library, and the Robert J. Novins Planetarium.

Porkies of Ontonagon County

Ski The Porkies in Ontonagon County

The Porkies has 11 miles of slope covering 100 acres over a 320 acre area. Since it is a state park ski area, the daily tow rates are the lowest of any comparable ski area.

From many vantage points along the trails, you can view the largest fresh water lake in the world - Lake Superior. Witness the ever changing ice patterns as far out on the lake as the eye can see. There's even an observation deck to help you enjoy the unparalleled view.

Lake Superior also works her magic in other ways - lake effect snows and moderate temperatures! Warmer air passing over the lake picks up moisture and deposits it as powder snow, up to as much as 20 feet in one season. Often, the daily winter temperatures are 10-20 degrees warmer than inland ski areas, which makes the Porkies even more attractive to the Winter sports enthusiast.
