I can make the same case for the ocean, without the light pollution part...

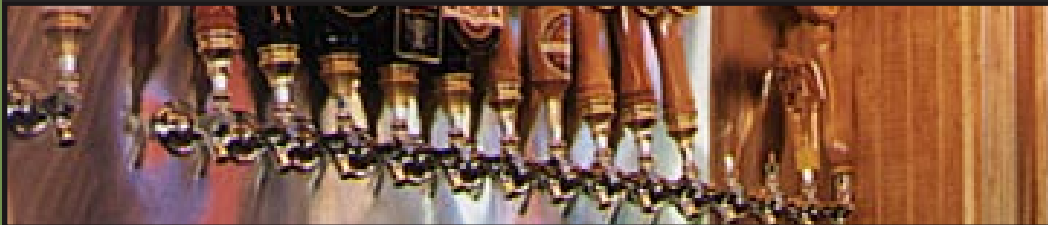

This stream-of-conscious rambling is coming to an end, thanks for indulging me.

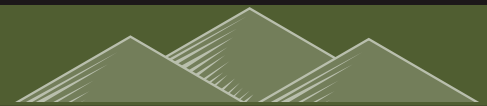

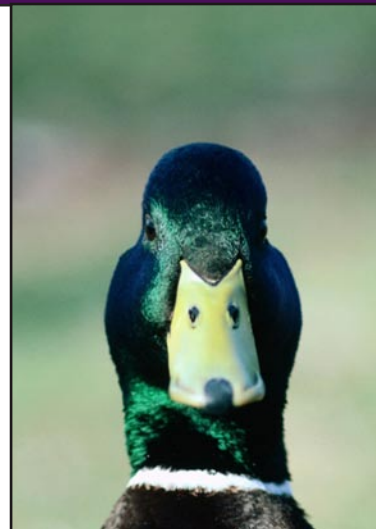
