Just as there are scores of unsung heroes of sport, there exist many an under appreciated brew. Summits decided to dedicate their March tasting as a tribute to ten beers you never heard of but should have.

Andy Klubock got on the scoreboard in a hurry by breaking out the Maredsous #8. Chimay may lead in name recognition, but the Maredsous is as rich, well balanced, and complex as any Belgium Brune I have tasted.



Maredsous was followed by Flying Dog In Heat Wheat; one of the few American Hefeweizens that holds true the German tradition. Next at bat were some undervalued gems from Germany: Dab Dark and Dinkle Acker Pils.

IPA. Recently reformulated, this English style bitter is not only a great session beer, but also a worthy competitor from the Pacific Northwest division of great ales.

Andy followed this aggressive beer with some milder unheralded Belgium Blondes: the Leffe and Dekonink. These ales tend to be crisper, more delicate, and more approachable than their stronger Abbey teammates.

After throwing the guests a wicked change up with Clausthaler (one of the only non alcoholics that actually taste like beer), Andy rounded out the evening with a great stout from an unlikely place, the Lion Stout of Sri Lanka.

This selection was an appropriate final at bat not only for Lion's desert like qualities but also provided an opportunity for a smooth transition into April's tasting, beers of South East Asia. Furthermore, 100 percent of proceeds will go to tsunami relief. Like the IRS always says in April..., "give until it hurts".

Cooking With Beer!

Beer Bread Mix in a Jar

(makes a great hostess gift)

- 1 1/2 cups all purpose unbleached flour
- 2/3 cup yellow corn meal
- 2 t. baking powder
- 1/2 t. salt
- 1/2 t. baking soda
- 2 T. brown sugar
- 2/3 cup parmesan cheese
- 1/2 t. crushed red pepper
- 4 t. dried minced onion

Layer brown sugar, corn meal, parmesan, red pepper, onion, and flour combined with baking powder, baking soda and salt in a pretty jar. Include a bottle of beer and the following directions.

Beer Bread

Place contents of jar in a medium mixing bowl. Stir in 12 ounces of beer, just until combined. Pour into a greased 8x4x2 inch loaf pan and bake at 375°F for 35 to 40 minutes or until a toothpick inserted in the centre comes out clean. Cover with foil during last 10 minutes to prevent overbrowning. Cool in pan 10 minutes, then transfer to a wire rack. Cool completely or serve warm.

The original driver has also been charged with drink-driving following the incident in Dornbirn.
