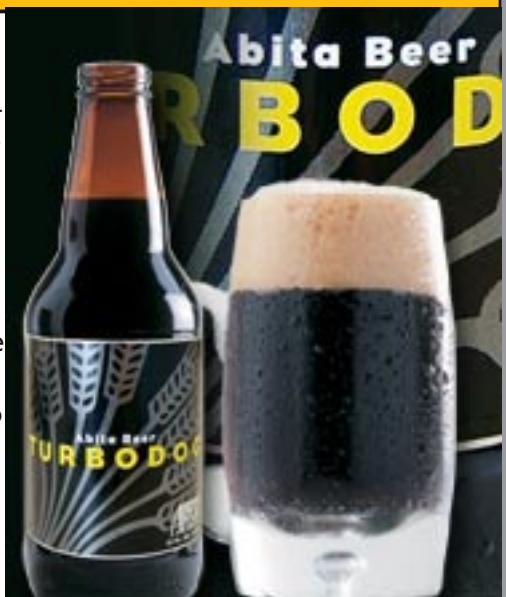
### TURBODOG

This combination gives Turbodog its rich body and color and a sweet chocolate-toffee like flavor. Turbodog began as a specialty ale but has gained a huge loyal following and has become one of our three flagship brews.

## Cooking With Beer!

### Beer-Battered Apple Fritters

#### Ingredients

vegetable oil, for deep-frying  
55-85g/2-3oz self-raising flour  
enough beer to make a batter  
2 apples, cored and diced  
55g/2oz plain flour  
55g/2oz dark chocolate, melted  
sprig of fresh mint

#### Method

1. Heat a pan one-third filled with vegetable oil, for deep-frying, until a breadcrumb will sizzle gently in it. (CAUTION: Hot oil can be very dangerous. Do not leave unattended.)
2. To make the batter, place the self-raising flour in a bowl and whisk in enough beer to create a batter, the consistency of double cream.
3. Coat the apple pieces in the plain flour. Dip the pieces in the batter and then deep-fry in the hot oil for 2-3 minutes, or until golden brown.
4. Carefully remove using a slotted spoon and drain on kitchen paper.
5. Transfer to a serving plate and drizzle with melted chocolate. Garnish with a sprig of mint to serve.
