Terrapin Cream Ale

CREAM ALE: America has always been a melting pot of people, their customs and their beers. By combining two major styles of brewing, ale and lager, a beer unique to this country was born. The Cream Ale.

Handcrafted using five types of malt and a generous amount of flaked maize, the Terrapin Cream Ale is our attempt to revive this classic American beer. It achieves its smoothness and drinkability by using an innovative brewing process known as "First Wort Hopping". With its golden hue, gentle complexity and white, creamy head, Terrapin Cream Ale is like sunshine in a glass.

Malt: 2-row pale, Munich, Vienna, Malted Wheat, Flaked Maize.

Hops: Cascade, Mt. Hood, Santium.

IBU's: 21 O.G.: 12.2 ABV: 5.0%

Cooking With Beer!

Beer Puffs

These flavorful puffs can be filled with crabmeat or whatever suits your fancy for a tasty appetizer.

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 cup beer
- 1/4 pound butter
- 1 cup sifted flour
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 4 eggs
- Filling of your choice

PREPARATION:

Preheat oven to 450 degrees F. Butter or oil a baking sheet or line with parchment paper.

In a heavy saucepan, heat beer and butter until it barely comes to a boil and the butter is melted. Add flour and salt, lower heat, and stir constantly until the mixture pulls away from the side of the pan and forms a ball. Remove from the heat and let rest for 1 minute. Add eggs, one at a time, beating each one in until the dough is shiny.

Drop or pipe dough in 1-inch rounds onto prepared baking pan. Bake 10 minutes at 450 degrees F. Reduce heat to 350 degrees F. Bake an additional 10 minutes until brown and dry. Let cool away from moisture.

Split beer puffs and fill with your choice of fillings such as paté chicken salad, tuna salad, seafood salad, vegetable cheese mix, or whatever you like.

Note: Feel free to add herbs or spices to the flour for added flavor.

Yield: 60 to 80 small puffs

Rogue Schwarzbier (Black Beer)

Schwarzbier is a German lager style, very dark brown in color with a tan-colored head. Coffee, coffee aromas mingled with nutty malt and a touch of caramel grace the nose. The palate is rich, smooth and clean, very malty with roasted notes apparent. The finish is lingering with a touch of residual sweetness and very mildly bitter.

Ingredients: pale malt, crystal 60, Munich, German Tradition and Oregon Sterling hops, Czech pils yeast- Lagered 6 weeks- unfiltered

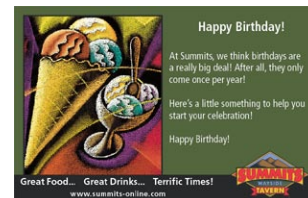
