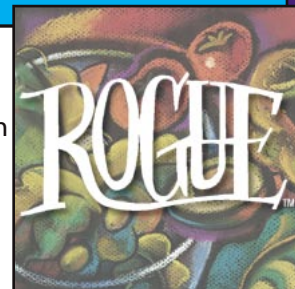

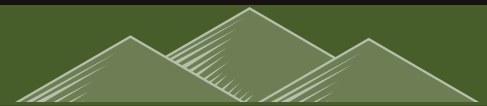
Rogue Juniper

Juniper Pale Ale: the new package for Yellow Snow Ale (winter 2004/2005). While the recipe (a pale ale infused with whole juniper berries) on the label remain the same, the name and label are new for 2005. Juniper Pale Ale is available in the classic 22-ounce bottle and on draft.

Measurements: 13 degrees Plato, IBU 34, Apparent Attenuation 77, Lovibond 3.2.

Speedy Stout Mocha Freeze

prep time : One to two hours
recipe type: dessert and sweets

ingredients:

- 1 quart coffee ice cream
- 1 cup stout
- 1 cup grated dark semi-sweet chocolate (I used Valrhona)



Soften ice cream in microwave for 15-30 seconds. Place in bowl of a large stand mixer. Mix in stout and grated chocolate. Mixture will be soft - pour into 1 cup ramekins and freeze until firm - about 4 hours. Serve with more stout.

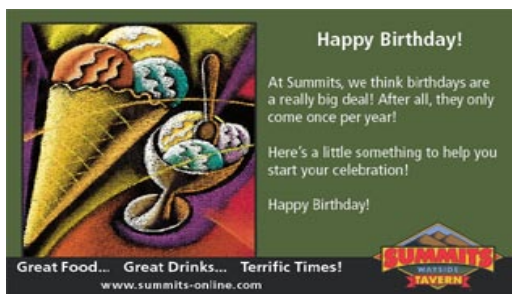
