Cooking With Beer

Beer Bread

- 3 cups self-rising flour
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 12 ounces beer
- 2 tablespoons melted butter

Preheat the oven to 375 degrees F.

Butter a loaf pan and set aside. In a large bowl, combine the flour, sugar, and beer and mix well. The mixture should be sticky. Pour into the loaf pan and bake for 55 minutes. At the last 3 minutes of baking, remove from oven, brush the top of the loaf with butter and return to oven.

Rogue for Oct 15th- Monk Madness

Monk Madness ~ "Let us give praise to our maker and glory to his bounty by learning about beer." ~ Friar Tuck

Monk Madness will debut in kegs as part of the Johns Locker Stock program before it is released to the Rogue Nation this winter in 22-ounce bottles. Five layers of malt create a complex, slightly sweet flavor balanced by five different hop varieties. The addition of free-range coastal waters and Rogue's proprietary PacMan Yeast make this 12-ingredient elixir something Friar Tuck would enjoy! We hope you do too!

Monk Madness Ale is brewed with 2-row Pale, Belgian Munich, Belgian Special B, Weyermann Melonodon, and Amber Malts; Belgian Nobles, Chinook, Amarillo, Centennial, and Summit Hops; measuring in at Plato 18 degrees, ABV 7.4 percent, 108 IBUs, 73 degrees Apparent Attenuation, and 66 Degrees Lovibond. A versatile and robust ale, we recommend pairing this with spicy foods, stong cheeses, and/or with desert.
