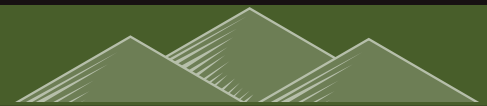
### Bacardi Mojito Madness!

## Spotlight on Beer

### Lagunitas Brewing Company

The Lagunitas Brewing Company was founded in 1993 by persons believed to have had ties to Cuban trained guerrillas working for the White House Plumbers, and assisted in providing wire-tap expertise as early as 1972. Today they are thought to live in hiding outside Tangiers under assumed names.

The company's 13th anniversary release; THE LUCKY 13 Ale, is a hoppy-sweet brew featuring the repulsive odor of burning tractor tires and sporting a rank flavor reminiscent of broccoli and kerosene. The finish is slightly stagnant but the lingering hop character threatens to take the enamel off your teeth. This unique ale earns its reputation by virtue of a strangely gooey mouthfeel and a gruesome

aftertaste. Enthusiasts who have encountered this new and widely feared ale have- on occasion- been treated for the chronic symptoms of trench mouth, Marburg virus, peritonitis, river blindness, goiter, and polyps. Lagunitas Ales generally exhibit a discontinuous turpitude and a flaccid rancor on the palate. Ribald and languid in body and finish, it is lewd and effluviant without being perspicacious.

Critics typically rank Lagunitas Ales a solid 7.635 x 10<sup>-23</sup>.



## Cooking With Beer

### Scotch Ale Spuds

#### Ingredients

- Big Big Russets
- Canola oil
- A BIG Scotch Ale (Bellhaven, McAndrews, Douglas)
- Chopped FRESH Rosemary (must be fresh!!!)
- Minced Shallots - about a half shotglass
- Salt and coarse fresh pepper to taste (Must be fresh pepper)

#### Instructions

Mix the ale and oil 3 to one with the other ingredients. Cut spuds into strange shapes about the size of a big toe. Toss the spuds into the marinade for an hour at room temperature. Stir it if you think of it. Remove the spuds to a big sheet of foil but allow some of the Rosemary and shallots to stick. Pour a shotglass of marinade over the spuds.

Seal the foil into a tight packet or crimp another sheet on top. Put on the barbecue grill for a half hour or a hot oven for 40 minutes. Your mileage may vary. Serve with any dish where a savory caramel note would compliment. I like it with lamb shanks.

## Beer Geek

Babylonians became the rulers of Mesopotamia. Their culture was derived from that of the Sumarians, and as a consequence of this, they also mastered the art of brewing beer. Today we know that the Babylonians new how to brew



20 different types of beer. Of these, 8 were brewed from pure emmer, 8 from pure barley and 4 from a mixture of grains. In Babylonian times beer was cloudy and unfiltered. The predecessor of the drinking straw was used to avoid getting the brewing residue, which was very bitter, in the mouth. Lager beer was even exported to Egypt, 1000 kilometers away. Hammurabi, an important Babylonian king and empire founder, decreed the oldest known collection of laws. One of these laws established a daily beer ration. This ration was dependent on the social standing of the individual. For example, a normal worker received 2 liters, civil servants 3 liters, and administrators and high priests 5 liters per day. In these ancient times beer was not sold, but exchanged for barley. As beer brewing was a household art, it was women's work. King Hammurabi ordered a female saloonkeeper drowned because she accepted silver for her beer. Drowning was also the punishment for serving low quality beer.
