Donation Information – FACTS

Make an informed decision – Information and knowledge is the key to making an informed decision. Organ donation is not about death, it is about life. The gift of life.



- Currently 97,000 plus nationally on the waiting list for organs – picture a football stadium at capacity – that's would represent approximately 88,000 people.
- Georgia – 1,900+ on list
- One body can help up to 60 people.
- Every 12 minutes someone is added to the waiting list.
- 18 people die daily while on the waiting list.
- Each day, about 74 people receive an organ transplant.
- 15,000 brain deaths in U.S., only 30% donate.
- Demand is far greater than supply although it is said that if everyone who could donate would, there would be no waiting list.
- Nationally: Transplants January - May 2007 11,746 as of 08/03/2007; Donors January - May 2007 75,868 as of 08/03/2007
- Brain death is the only way to donate organs, must have heart and lung function to donate
- No age restrictions to donate

- Most people agree with donation, they don't discuss with family.

What can be donated?

- Organs: heart, kidneys, pancreas, lungs, liver, and intestines
- Tissue: cornea, skin, bone marrow, heart valves, and connective tissue
- Bone marrow

Cooking With Beer

Scotch Ale Spuds

Ingredients

Big Big Russets
Canola oil
A BIG Scotch Ale (Bellhaven, McAndrews, Douglas)
Chopped FRESH Rosemary (must be fresh!!!)
Minced Shallots - about a half shotglass
Salt and coarse fresh pepper to taste (Must be fresh pepper)

Instructions

Mix the ale and oil 3 to one with the other ingredients. Cut spuds into strange shapes about the size of a big toe. Toss the spuds into the marinade for an hour at room temperature. Stir it if you think of it. Remove the spuds to a big sheet of foil but allow some of the Rosemary

and shallots to stick. Pour a shotglass of marinade over the spuds.

Seal the foil into a tight packet or crimp another sheet on top. Put on the barbecue grill for a half hour or a hot oven for 40 minutes. Your mileage may vary. Serve with any dish where a savory caramel note would compliment. I like it with lamb shanks.

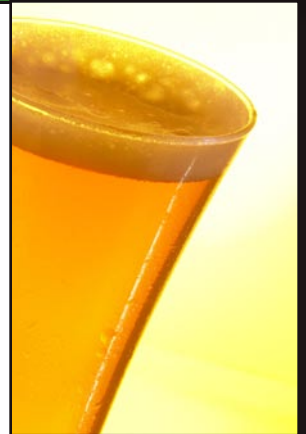

Question: What is so special about a "microbrewery"?

Answer: Microbrewery: A brewery that produces less than 15,000 barrels (17,600 hectoliters) of beer per year. Microbreweries sell to the public by one or more of the following methods: the traditional three-tier system (brewer to wholesaler to retailer to consumer); the two-tier system (brewer acting as wholesaler to retailer to consumer); and, directly to the consumer through carryouts and/or on-site tap-room or restaurant sales.
