Thursday: Fried Chicken Dinner

Friday: Beef on Weck Sandwich (beginning February)

Summits will have its own version of this popular northern favorite!

This is a roast beef sandwich on a salty kummelweck roll. In fact, it is this roll that makes the sandwich unique. Made only in the Buffalo-Rochester area, the kummelweck—often alternatively spelled kimmelweck—is basically a Kaiser roll topped with lots of pretzel salt and caraway seeds. Kummelweck is simply shortened to "weck." The sandwich is usually served with sinus-clearing horseradish (you can tell a native Buffalonian by the amount of horseradish he or she used), a couple of huge kosher dill pickle slices on the side, and extra beef juice served straight from the roast. Wash it all down with a cold, locally brewed ale. (www.whatscookingamerica.net)

Beer Recipe

Budweiser Pancakes

- 3 cups flour
- 3 teaspoons baking powder
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 2 tablespoons sugar
- 3 eggs, separated
- 1 cup Budweiser or other lager beer, room temperature
- 1 1/2 cups milk
- 1/3 cup melted butter

Mix together flour, baking powder, salt and sugar.

Beat the egg yolks with a fork. Stir in beer, milk and butter. Add to dry ingredients and beat until smooth.

Beat egg whites until stiff peaks form; fold into batter.

Drop batter by spoonfuls onto a hot, greased griddle. Turn when batter rises and entire surface is dotted with holes.

Yield: 18-24 pancakes, depending on size

Beer Geek

What is the best way to pour beer?

Definitely into a clean glass or mug after a good rinse with cold water. Only then bubbles will not stick to the glass surface inside and the true amber color will show at its best. Draft beer is poured at one go - i.e. you open the tap once. When emptying a bottle or can we pour beer on the side of the glass until it is 2/3 full and top the rest from above crowing the glass with a two-finger thick head and giving it a truly royal appearance.



Rogue's Old Crustacean!

Newport, OR - In Britain, seasonal brews for winter are high in alcohol, robust, malty, and dark. The two main styles of these brews are Old Ales and Barleywines. As the name suggests, barleywines are similar to wines in alcohol and need aging but are derived from grain, not the grape. Rogue's barleywine is described by beer expert Stuart Ramsey as: "A masterful, intense creation from brewer John Maier....it has achieved a depth and complexity usually associated with well-ages strong ales. I hope the brewery bottles some before it disappears." We call it the cognac of beers. An unfiltered and unfinned Barleywine. Intense, robust, malty and dark. The cognac of beers. A huge beer in a little bottle, this is a beer designed for sipping.

Old Crustacean is brewed with eight ingredients, Great Western Harrington, Klages, Hugh Baird Carastan and Munich Malts, Chinook and Centennial Hops, free-range coastal water and PacMan yeast. Old Crustacean is best when aged for one year. Measurements: 26 degrees Plato, IBU 120, Apparent Attenuation 73.1, Lovibond 38.

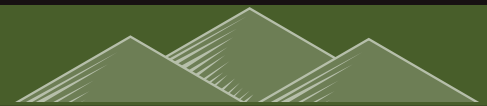
