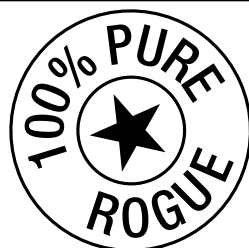

## Don't Forget - Special Dinners at Summits...

### Tuesday: Family Night

Every Tuesday from 5:00 pm - 9:00 pm you will get a FREE kid's meal for each adult meal that is purchased. This is a dine in only program for children under 12 please. So, if you don't feel like going home prepare dinner after soccer practice or swimming lessons stop by Summits!

### Thursday: Fried Chicken Dinner

Every Thursday from 5:00 pm until 9:00 pm we prepare homemade fried chicken! Hand battered and breaded and served with fried green beans and homemade garlic mashed potatoes. This rivals grandma's recipe!

### Friday: Beef on Weck Sandwich (beginning February)

Summits will have its own version of this popular northern favorite! This is a roast beef sandwich on a salty kummelweck roll. In fact, it is this roll that makes the sandwich unique. Made only in the Buffalo-Rochester area, the kummelweck—often alternatively spelled kimmelweck—is basically a Kaiser roll topped with lots of pretzel salt and caraway seeds. Kummelweck is simply shortened to "weck." The sandwich is usually served with sinus-clearing horseradish (you can tell a native Buffalonian by the amount of horseradish he or she used), a couple of huge kosher pickle.



## Beer Recipe

### Southwestern XX Marinade

This light, tangy marinade is great for grilling. Marinate your chicken, beef, or anything else before tossing on the grill. Great with shrimp.

- 1/4 cup oil (If you use olive oil, use lighter oil, not extra virgin)
- 8 cloves garlic, chopped
- 4 shallots, chopped
- 1 cup onion, chopped
- 2 jalapeño peppers, seeds and stems removed
- 1 bunch cilantro, chopped
- 1/4 cup soy sauce
- 3 tablespoons Worcestershire sauce
- 8 ounces Mexican beer (we use Dos Equis, thus the name of the marinade)
- 2 tablespoons black pepper
- Juice of 6 limes

In blender or large food processor, place all the ingredients. Blend until smooth.

Gives you about 2 cups of marinade

Centuries ago in England, pub visitors used a novel innovation that enabled them to get their beer served quickly.

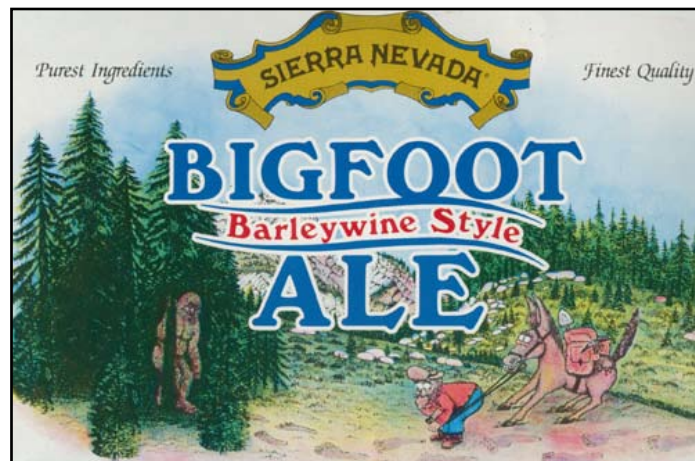
They used mugs with a whistle baked into the rim, the whistle being used to summon the barmaid. It has been suggested this practice gave birth to the phrase "wet your whistle."
