# **Cooking With Beer!**

### **Bourbon Stout Yam Waffles**

From Real Beer and Good Eats by Bruce Aidells & Dennis Kelly (Random House), for About.com

Stout beer gives a wonderful yeasty flavor to waffles while the yams add a gentle sweetness. These are great for breakfast, but also good for dinner as a change of pace.

**Ingredients:** 

1-1/2 cups flour

1 Tablespoon baking powder

1/2 teaspoon salt

3 eggs, separated

1/2 cup milk

1/2 cup Stout

2 Tablespoons bourbon

1 cup mashed cooked yams, cooled

2 Tablespoons melted butter

Pinch each nutmeg, cardamom, and ginger

#### **Directions**

Sift together the flour, baking powder, and salt. Beat the egg yolks and mix them with the milk, Stout, bourbon, yams, melted butter, and spices. Beat the egg whites until they form soft peaks and fold them into the batter. Cook like ordinary waffles, following your waffle iron instructions. Pour on plenty of good-quality maple syrup.

Yield: 6 waffles with enough for seconds

## **Beer Geek**

#### **Brown Ale**

Includes English, American, Belgian and Dusseldorf-style Brown Ales which are described below. English Brown Ale Back in the time when most beers were darker (1920's), Newcastle presented their reddish brown ale to compete with the Pale Ales of the day. This style has proven so enduring that it has sparked many copycats and has lead to the emergence of a new style. These nuttier Brown ales are very different from the older brown ales from the London area, which are lower in alcohol, darker and sweeter.

English Brown Ales range from deep copper to brown in color. They have a medium body, and a dry to sweet maltiness dominates with very little hop flavor or aroma. Fruity ester flavors are appropriate. Diacetyl should be very low, if evident. Chill haze is allowable at cold temperatures. Classic Producers: Newcastle Brown Ale (Scottish & Newcastle Breweries, Tyne Brewery, England), Nut Brown Ale (Samuel Smith's Brewing, England)

Bohemian Black Lager, crafted according to exacting old-world standards with imported Czech Saaz, Styrians Hops and selected roasted malts, is the darkest beer that Shiner brews.
