What's New at the Summit?

April Showers..... Ways to Conserve Water

We've had a few rainy weeks but that does not mean that we should stop conserving our water! Below are a few great ways that we can all use just a little bit less water in our homes and leave a little bit more for Mother Nature to enjoy!



1. Use your water meter to check for hidden water leaks
2. Check your toilets for leaks
3. Don't use the toilet as an ashtray or wastebasket. Every time you flush a cigarette butt, facial tissue or other small bit of trash, five to seven gallons of water is wasted.
4. Put plastic bottles or float booster in your toilet tank. To cut down on water waste, put an inch or two of sand or pebbles inside each of two plastic bottles to weigh them down. Fill the bottles with water, screw the lids on, and put them in your toilet tank, safely away from the operating mechanisms. This may save ten or more gallons of water per day. Be sure at least 3 gallons of water remain in the tank so it will flush properly. Or, low flow toilets, of course
5. Insulate your water pipes.
6. Install water-saving shower heads and low-flow faucet aerators
7. Take shorter showers.
8. Turn off the water after you wet your toothbrush
9. Rinse your razor in the sink
10. Check faucets and pipes for leaks. A small drip from a worn faucet washer can waste 20 gallons of water per day. Larger leaks can waste hundreds of gallons.
11. Use your dishwasher and clothes washer for only full loads
12. Minimize use of kitchen sink garbage disposal units
13. When washing dishes by hand, don't leave the water running for rinsing
14. Don't let the faucet run while you clean vegetables
15. Keep a bottle of drinking water in the fridge.

Beer Geek

GUINNESS From the Tap:

The perfect pint of Guinness is served using the 'two-part' pour:

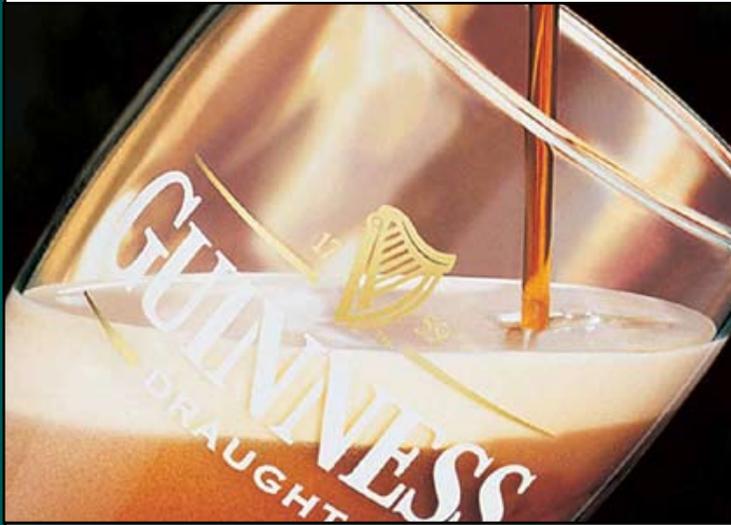
Select a clean, dry glass - hold the glass at 45 degrees under the spout.

Pull the handle slowly towards you and allow the beer to flow smoothly down the side of the glass (note: do not submerge the spout in the beer).

As the glass fills, straighten the glass - fill glass until full.

Stand the glass on the counter and allow the gas to surge through the beer.

To create the legendary head, push the handle backward slightly (this is known as "topping off"). The head should rise just proud of the rim.

(Portland, OR)

This award-winning IPA sparkles with effervescence, the result of natural-conditioning, a process where the beer is double-fermented in each bottle, keg or cask. Brewed with a blend of five hop varieties, BridgePort IPA presents a floral, citrusy aroma and full hop flavor, while downplaying the bitterness. The beer pours smooth in the glass, emitting its signature golden glow.



Cooking With Beer!

Here are basic rules-of-thumb when first cooking with beer:

- § The more the beer is cooked and reduced, the stronger its flavor will be. If the dish requires long cooking and reduction, avoid using too strong a brew, lest you end up overdoing it.
- § Finally, sample some beers to understand the range of flavors. If you can imagine a beer going well with a particular dish as a beverage, then it would likely make a good ingredient as well.
