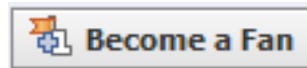

Apricot Ale Frozen Custard

prep time : Advance prep required

recipe type: dessert and sweets

Ingredients:

- 12 oz. Pyramid Apricot Ale
- 8 oz. apricot preserves
- 1 large egg
- 1 cup sugar
- 1/2 cup whole milk
- 2 cups heavy whipping cream

Directions

Pour ale and preserves into a heavy saucepan and simmer to reduce to 1 1/2 cups, remove from heat. Mix the egg and sugar in a bowl. Mix in milk, then mix in the warm apricot ale concentrate. Mix in cream. Chill ale-cream blend in refrigerator for about an hour. Freeze in ice cream maker according to manufacturer's instructions. Makes around 2 quarts.

This Week in History - 8/24

August 25 On this day in 1835, the first in a series of six articles announcing the supposed discovery of life on the moon appears in the New York Sun newspaper. Known collectively as "The Great Moon Hoax," the articles were supposedly reprinted from the Edinburgh Journal of Science.

August 26 On this day in 1939, the first televised Major League baseball game is broadcast on station W2XBS, the station that was to become WNBC-TV. Announcer Red Barber called the game between

the Cincinnati Reds and the Brooklyn Dodgers at Ebbets Field in Brooklyn, New York.

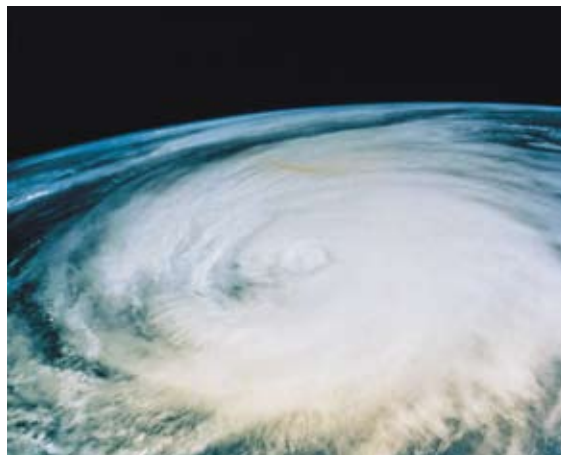
August 27 The most powerful volcanic eruption in recorded history occurs on Krakatau (also

called Krakatoa), a small, uninhabited volcanic island located west of Sumatra in Indonesia, on this day in 1883. Heard 3,000 miles away, the explosions threw five cubic miles of earth 50 miles into the air, created 120-foot tsunamis and killed 36,000 people.

August 28 After four years of separation, Charles, Prince of Wales and heir to the British throne, and his wife, Princess Diana, formally divorce.

August 29 On this date in 2005, Hurricane Katrina makes landfall near New Orleans, Louisiana, as a

Category 4 hurricane on this day in 2005. Despite being only the third most powerful storm of the 2005 hurricane season, Katrina was the worst natural disaster in the history of the United States.
