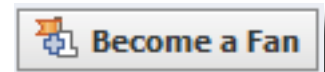

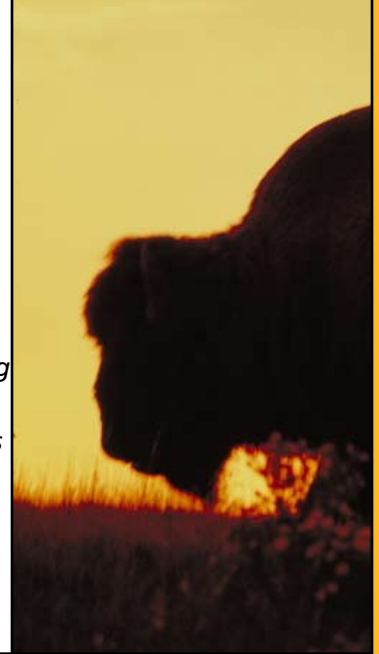

Spicy Spiked Ice Cream

prep time : Advance prep required
recipe type: dessert and sweets

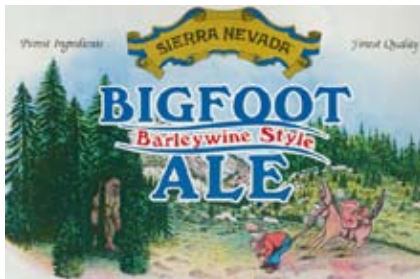
Ingredients:

- 12 oz. barleywine or spicy brew
- 1 tablespoon cinnamon
- 2 oz. orange liqueur 1 large egg plus one yolk
- 1 cup sugar
- 1/2 cup milk
- 2 cups heavy whipping cream

Directions

Blend barleywine with cinnamon, liqueur, egg and yolk, sugar, and milk in quart top of double-boiler. Whisk till smooth. Simmer in top of double boiler to make a custard, stirring often with the whisk to prevent clumping or curdling. When thick, remove from heat and let cool. Mix in cream and strain. Chill mixture in refrigerator for about an hour. Freeze in ice cream maker according to the manufacturer's instructions.

Makes around 2 quarts.

- The first United States Marine Recruiting Station was in a bar.

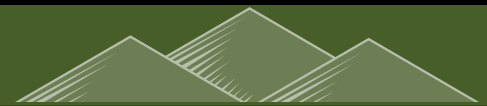

This Week in History - 8/31

August 31, 1967 Diana, Princess of Wales, dies in Paris' Pitie-Salpetiere Hospital after suffering massive chest injuries in an early morning car accident. Her companion, Dodi Fayed, was killed instantly in the 12:25 a.m. crash, as was driver Henri Paul

September 1st On this day in 1864, Union Army General William Tecumseh Sherman lays siege to Atlanta, a critical Confederate hub, shelling civilians and cutting off supply lines. The Confederates retreated, destroying the city's munitions as they went. On November 15 of that year, Sherman's troops burned much of the city before continuing their march through the South. Sherman's Atlanta campaign was one of the most decisive victories of the Civil War.

September 2nd On this day in 1969, America's first automatic teller machine (ATM) makes its public debut, dispensing cash to customers at Chemical Bank in Rockville Center, New York.

September 3, 1783 The American Revolution officially comes to an end when representatives of the United States, Great Britain, Spain and France sign the Treaty of Paris on this day in 1783.

September 4th On this day in 1886, Apache chief Geronimo surrenders to U.S. government troops. For 30 years, the mighty Native American warrior had battled to protect his tribe's homeland; however, by 1886 the Apaches were exhausted and hopelessly outnumbered. General Nelson Miles accepted Geronimo's surrender, making him the last Indian warrior to formally give in to U.S. forces and signaling the end of the Indian Wars in the Southwest.

September 5th On this day in 1972, at the Summer Olympics in Munich, Germany, a group of Palestinian terrorists storms the Olympic Village apartment of the Israeli athletes, killing two and taking nine others hostage.
